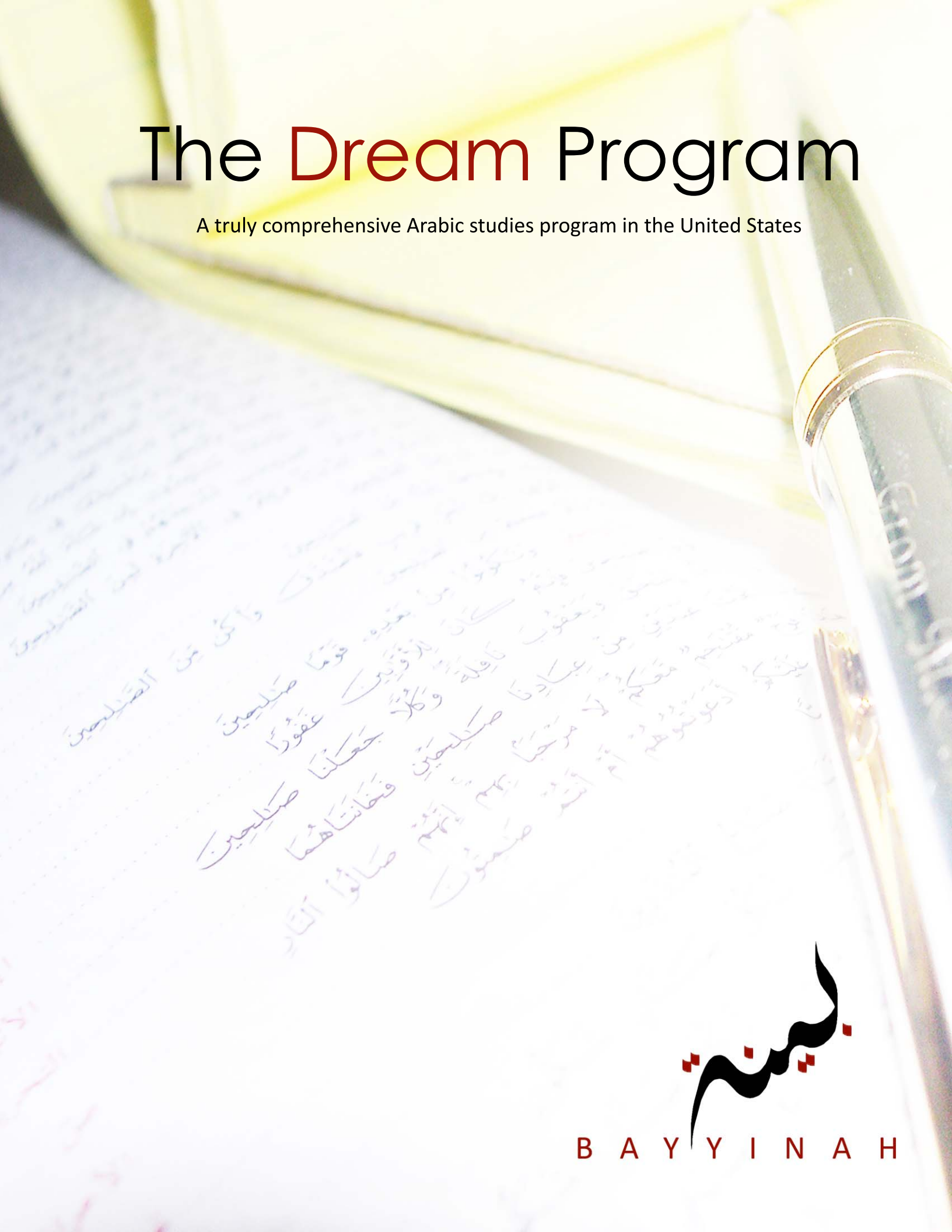

Application Information

Please be advised, the application itself contains a series of personal questions intended to learn more about potential applicants. The questions themselves are not indicative of any specific pre-requisites so please fill them out freely and honestly. The pre-requisites for admission are listed below:

- Must have high school diploma or equivalent (GED). The only exceptions are minors that will be accepted into the program along with a guardian (minimum age for minors is 12).
- Students must pass a basic Qur'an reading fluency and tajweed screening test to be delivered over the phone.
- Tuition for the 10 month program is \$7,750. payment is due in full on July 10th in the form of certified bank check only. Bayyinah will not cover room/board. Living expenses and arrangements are the responsibility of the individual student. If tuition is not received by July 10th, 2010, then the application is deemed null and void. Tuition can be refunded in the amount of 70% in case of extenuating circumstances by August 15th, 2010. After August 15th, tuitions will be non-refundable.
- Students must read and abide by the Bayyinah Dream code of conduct throughout the duration of the program. Bayyinah reserves the right to take disciplinary action (including expulsion) without refund for code of conduct violations.

Application Procedure

- Application must be filled out in full, and application fee of \$150 (via PayPal at the bottom of the online application form) must be received by June 1st. Applications will CLOSE on June 1st. Applications and application fees will only be processed online. Once the submitted application is reviewed, students will receive a follow up email to schedule a phone interview. At the conclusion of this interview, the reading fluency phone interview will be scheduled within the same week (sisters will interview sisters and brothers will interview brothers for this call). This completes phase 1 of the interview process.
- Students selected to proceed to phase 2 will have two additional phone interviews scheduled with Bayyinah faculty. Acceptance letters will be e-mailed out on June 15th, 2010. Bayyinah reserves the right to deny any application, and is not obligated to furnish reasons for acceptance or denial of applications.
- Prospective students will receive information packets with local housing information, and a point of contact for facilitating roommate requests.
