Unit 3B: IRREGULARITIES

This unit is dedicated to the study of a number of issues in صرف that weren't already covered in Unit 2.

3A OBJECTIVES:

1. A systematic breakdown of irregularities in conjugation depending on where the vowel occurs.

WHAT IS AN IRREGULARITY IN CONJUGATION?

Whenever an ا, و, or ي is involved in the root letters, the conjugation is considered irregular. Another scenario for irregular conjugations occurs when two of the root letters are the same. Irregularities are categorized based on the position of the irregular letter. The following basic breakdown will give you an overview of the different irregularity scenarios:

- a. أَجْوَف: When the ع letter is a vowel.
- b. مُضَاعَف: When the ع and ل letters are the same.
- c. مِثَال: When the ف letter is a vowel
- d. نَائِص: When the ل letter is a vowel

There are in fact two other scenarios that are discussed by grammarians. They will be the subject of a supplemental study which in my opinion should not be given too much emphasis because of the instances being relatively less common.

نَصَرَ is clearly three syllables. نَاب is actually based on the letters ت و ب but instead of the past tense being pronounced تَوَّب, it is pronounced نَاب. Three letters in Arabic are considered vowels: ا, و, and ي. If any of these three are part of the base letter, there are complications in the conjugation. To make this complex system simple to understand, bear in mind two main concepts:

- a. The ا, و, and ي are interchangeable depending on what will sound the smoothest. Just because you see an ا in the past tense, it is no guarantee that there is an ا in the original root letters. It may be substituting for a و or a ي.

- b. The **ا** is associated with a فتحة , the **و** is associated with a ضمة and the **ي** is associated with the كسرة . We will understand what this means in practical terms when we conjugate irregular cases.

VOWEL IN THE MIDDLE; أَجُوف :

The gray cells represent conjugations that actually don't make sense for قَالَ but might make sense for other أَجُوف conjugations. The passive doesn't make sense in certain numbers and persons even if it does in one of them. For instance, the first word قِيلَ means *it was said* the قُلْتِ in the passive means *I was said* which, of course, doesn't make any sense.

The 'u' in قُلْنَ came from the **و** in the root. In other words, the reason we don't say قُلْنَ or قُلْنَ but say قُلْنَ instead because the root letters are **ق** , **و** , **ل** and the **و** is associated with the ضمة . (see comment 'b' above).

Once you figure out how to conjugate the هُرْنَ (those women) version which is قُلْنَ, the rest retains the قُلْ and adds a ت , تُنَّ , تُنَّ , تُنَّ , تُنَّ and نا at the ends.

The passive present is 'u' followed by 'a'. يَقُولُ has a long 'oo' so it's only fair that it be replaced in passive form with a long 'aa'. The feminine plural would have been يُقَالَنَّ but that isn't allowed because a long sound and سُكُون can't coexist in the middle of an Arabic word. Therefore, the l is sacrificed leaving behind يَقُلْنَ in active and يُقَلْنَ in passive.

Instead of the middle letter و being used in قَائِلٌ, it is always replaced with a همزة as قَائِلٌ. The و in مَقُولٌ is there because the middle root letter is a و. Had it been a ي, the اسم مفعول would have been with a باع for example yields the اسم فاعل , بائع and the اسم مفعول , مبيع. The gray indicates the usage

that doesn't make any sense under any circumstance. The rest might exist as they are all possibly used for non-humans.

The original was meant to be عَدَدَّ but was fused in most cases to form عَدَّ. When we reach هُنَّ, the سُكُون is necessary before the addition of نَ. It would be impossible to have شَدَّ and سُكُون on the same letter, so at that point in the conjugation and from then on, the two letters were separated. Keep in mind that an irregular conjugation of three letters still belongs to one of the six families identified in 3A. The word عَدَّ happens to be from the نَصَرَ family, which is why the present tense is يَعُدُّ, not يَعْدُ or يَعِدُّ. On the other hand, the word ضَلَّ is from the ضَرَبَ family, which is why the present tense is يَضِلُّ, not يَصَلُّ or يَضَلُّ.

The real ل letter is ي, but instead of reading هَدَيْ , the Arabs read هَدَى (refer to point a). The ي comes back in the pair but becomes a fixture from هُنَّ and onwards (هَدَيْنَ).
